



Admission Criteria:

- __1. **Application for Admission**
- __2. **Official Transcripts:** High School (HS diploma awarded) or GED; College (if applicable)
- __3. **Demonstrate Academic Preparation** (English, Math and Computer skills)

Requirements must be met **within 5 yrs.** of the admission year

- English/Math: Placement Test scores and/or Remedial Courses.
- Computer: Must be prepared to take online courses by taking CIS 110 (grade of "C" or better) **OR** a satisfactory score on the TPE (Technical Proficiency Exam).

AND/OR

- Transferable College level **ENG, MATH, and CIS (Computer)** courses within 5 years of the admission year (2005 or later for 2010).

- __4. **Attend a Dental Assisting Information Session:** *Students should attend a session the year of or the year prior to admission (see schedule on the web site).* **Failure to attend may delay your admission process.**

Complete and submit the following paperwork at the end of the Information Session:

- Program Survey
- Statement of Understanding Regarding Clinical Training
- Technical Standards

Attach the following to the Admission Qualification form* and submit to Student Services:

- __5. Complete Hepatitis B series: Documentation of **three** (3) injections must be provided.
- __6. Current **CPR** and **AED** certification (**Health Care Provider** level including adult, child, and infant). Documentation is a copy of your unexpired card.

After completing steps 1-6, **turn in Admission Qualification Form** . * Forms are available online, in Student Services and at the Dental Information session. Your qualification date will be the date all admission criteria are met.

Steps 1 – 6 listed above should be completed by January 1, 2010 for priority consideration.

****Please note: Students will be considered up to July 1, 2010 if space is available.**

Complete steps 7 – 9 AFTER you have been notified of conditional approval (forms will be provided):

- __7. **Background Report:** It is recommended to obtain a report if *there may be a past record of a charge of a misdemeanor/felony to possibly clear the record before investing money and time in any program prerequisites.*
- __8. **Physical Examination/Drug Screen and Dental examination (within 6 months of program entry)**
- __9. **Submit documentation of Hepatitis B Quantitative titer.**
