

At RCCC, we offer **four** different **nursing programs of study**. Occasionally, a student might choose one when, in fact, their interest is in another. Please read the following program descriptions carefully and be sure that you have chosen the program you want.

- **A1010I – Associate of Arts (college transfer)**

The student is taking courses at the community college level and is planning to transfer on to a university to complete their BSN (Bachelor of Science in Nursing). The student will not be taking the state board exam to become a RN until their BSN curriculum is complete. *Some students may decide to pursue their MSN (Master of Science in Nursing) later at a university.*

- **A45110 – Associate Degree Nursing (ADN)**

The student's program of study will end at the community college level. This program prepares the student to take the state board exam to become a registered nurse (RN). *Some students may decide to pursue their BSN later at a university.*

- **D45660 – Practical Nursing (LPN)**

The student's program of study will end at the community college level. This program prepares the student to take the state board exam to become a licensed practical nurse (LPN). *Some students may decide to pursue their A.D.N. later in a completion program.*

- **A45110C – LPN Transition**

The student is currently a licensed practical nurse (LPN) and is coming back to college to complete the requirements to take the state board exam to become a registered nurse (RN). *Some students may decide to pursue their BSN later at a university.*
