

FINANCIAL AID PROBATION STATEMENT

You are eligible for financial aid!

- You are on probation and financial aid will pay while on probation. This means that you have unsatisfactory academic progress by having excessive withdrawals or a G.P.A. (Grade Point Average) of less than a 2.0 (“C”) or possibly a combination of the two.
- Students on probation are NOT permitted to register during EARLY REGISTRATION! All grades must be recorded by admissions before probation can be lifted. Once lifted, students can register during Open Registration.
- In order to continue receiving financial assistance for your next enrolled semester, it is required that you use this probation period to improve your situation. Withdrawals, failing or incomplete grades while on probation may cause you to become ineligible for future aid.
- You must sign this statement indicating that you understand you are on probation and have read the enclosed Satisfactory Academic Progress Standards. If satisfactory academic progress is NOT met, your financial aid will be terminated. It will be up to you to pay out-of-pocket for future semesters at RCCC.
- Once your G.P.A. reaches a 2.0 or higher and you have consistently made good grades, your financial aid can be reinstated. *Your financial aid may be reinstated when satisfactory academic progress has been met. Satisfactory progress requires a 2.0 cumulative GPA and a 67% completion rate of all curriculum classes taken at RCCC.*
