WRITING AN ESSAY— THE FIRST DRAFT

Begin the first draft for your paper after gathering and organizing sufficient material for the essay.

Do not assume that the first draft will be the final draft. Allow time to work on several drafts of an essay, Don't wait until the last minute.

REVISING THE ESSAY

Put the essay aside for a short time before writing the second draft. Review your notes and other information gathered during the research process. Rewrite the essay including any additional information as necessary.

Read your essay and note any changes that should be made.

Ask yourself —

- Is the topic focused
- Is the introduction clear
- Are there clear examples
- Do the sentences work well
- Are the paragraphs effective
- Is the purpose of the essay accomplished

If you answered yes to the questions above, write the essay again

COMPUTER GENERATED ESSAYS

Make sure the computer formats are set according to the instructor's specifications. Final copies should be printed on white paper and pages should be numbered. Include a title page, works cited page and end notes or footnotes, as required. Save your essay!
