Information for you

.com

When using the Internet, you must use a search engine to locate information on your topic.

Yahoo.com, Ask.com, Google.com, etc. Even SIRS has a .com as an extension. These extensions are part of the URL or address of a particular Internet provider. These providers will connect you to the millions of pieces of information about your topic. It is then up to the user to determine the best sources.

There are other extensions that link users to

information such as .gov, .org, .edu. These stand for government resources, organizations and education resources.

These are sources for information that the user can rely on to be knowledgeable and correct.

Check out all information! Don't rush and use the first source you find!
