Step Four: Access your class(es) in Blackboard!

Noon, **January 11, 2010.**

Login access to Internet classes begins for 2nd 8-week minimesters: **Noon, March 17.**

It is strongly encouraged that students begin working in their Internet Classes on the first day of class.

- 1st 8-week minimester: January 14
- 2nd 8-week minimester: March 22

Step Five: Participate!

- Actively participate in the Internet course and weekly contact with the instructor.
- Adhere to the testing requirements of the instructor, including on-campus testing if specified.

Internet Classes

These classes are delivered via the Internet through a variety of online techniques such as lecture, video clips, online discussions, e-mail exchanges, chats, and case studies to mention a few. Internet students have no scheduled sessions on campus, although instructors reserve the right to require test-taking in the on-campus testing center. Internet classes are designed to give the student maximum flexibility; however, the student is expected to meet assignment and testing deadlines which provide a framework to promote student progress.

Online Orientation

All students who are new to Internet classes at RCCC are required to complete the Online Orientation prior to receiving access to their course.

If a student has not previously completed an Internet, Hybrid, or TeleWeb course at RCCC with a grade of "C" or better, he/she must have completed the following classes successfully*, received equivalent transfer credit for the courses, or must be enrolled in the courses at the time of pre-registration and expecting successful completion* prior to the beginning of the new semester/term.

- ENG 111 or both ENG 090 and RED 090 (or equivalent). If not, the student may enroll if he/she has achieved a Reading placement test score and Writing/Language placement test score that qualifies the student for placement into ENG 111.
- CIS 110, EGR 125, or EDU 271 (or equivalent). If not, the student may enroll if he/she has achieved a placement test score of 77 or better on the Technical Proficiency Exam.
**Successful completion is achieved by a grade of "C" or better (includes grades of "CE" but excludes "Audits").*

Step 2: Register and Pay

Step 3: Attend the First Face-to-Face Class

- **Hybrid courses meet on campus on specified days. See the Schedule for locations, times and dates.**
- **Attendance in the first class meeting is mandatory.** Attendance at all scheduled class meetings is expected. *Those students who do not attend the first class meeting and do not meet with the instructor during the following week will be dropped immediately.*
- All students who are enrolled in a Hybrid course will complete the orientation in Blackboard during the first face-to-face class session. Once the orientations steps are complete, the instructor will turn access on for each student in the Hybrid course.

Step 4: Access Your Class in Blackboard and Participate!

- Use your college email account for all e-mail communication.
- After your first face-to-face class, be sure to login to Blackboard each week, or as directed by your instructor. (<http://rcc.blackboard.com>)
- Many Hybrid courses offer the online portion of the course as the primary instructional environment, with the face to face sessions used for follow-up, hands on activities and presentation sessions.
- Students taking Hybrid courses must attend all on-campus sessions and complete the online coursework.
- Actively participate in the online portion of the course and keep in contact with the instructor.
- Meet assignment and testing deadlines set by the instructor.

Hybrid Course

This type of class combines an Internet Course with face-to-face instruction. A large amount of the course is delivered as an Internet course, accompanied by on-campus meetings for lecture, discussion, and presentations.

Hybrid courses meet on campus on specified days (*see the semester schedule for locations, times and dates*).

Students will not have access to the Blackboard (Internet) portion of the course until the Instructor's first meeting with the class.

Hybrid Student Attendance

Attendance in the first class meeting is mandatory. Attendance at all scheduled class meetings is expected. *Those students who do not attend the first class meeting and do not meet with the instructor during the following week will be dropped immediately.*

Hybrid Orientation

All students who are enrolled in a Hybrid course will complete the orientation in Blackboard during the first face-to-face class session. Once the orientations steps are complete, the instructor will turn access on for each student in the Hybrid course.
