The meeting was called to order at 9:36 am

Robert's rules of order were suspended until the end of the meeting due to the request of Quinn Shay.

The current SGA President was voted in by the student body in April of 2009 and began term in July of 2009. Upon completion of the spring term, it was brought to the attention of the executive board that the president no longer met the requirements as outlined in the SGA Constitution. The Constitution states that in the absence of the President, the VP would serve. The SGA VP has not yet been elected. This office is filled in the fall term to allow 1st and 2nd year candidates to apply.

After discussion, the executive board agreed to elect and interim president from the current board to serve as Acting SGA President until September 1. The student body present at this scheduled and publicized meeting will elect a new SGA President and VP.

Duties of the Interim president would include: Taking responsibility for going to Trustees meetings, coordinating planned events, office hours as outlined in the Constitution and chairing the September 1 Student Business Meeting.

After discussion ended Robert's rules of order were back in place.

A motion was put forth by Lyndsey McGonagle (Public information officer, South Campus) that Karen Isenhour, current membership officer be Interim President until September 1st 2009, at which time if a president is not in place then a second executive meeting may be called to address the situation.

The motion was properly seconded and passed unanimously (3 for, 0 against, 0 abstained).

The meeting was adjourned at 10:49 am.
